COVID-19 PANDEMIC RESPONSE: THE ROLE OF PUBLIC HEALTH

Since March of 2020 it's been an all hands-on-deck approach at LRDHU. Countless staff hours have been utilized for testing and vaccinations. With that comes planning, logistics, acquiring supplies, public information, mask fit-testing, educating, onboarding of extra staff, meetings, advisory roles, learning new registration and data entry programs, coordinating 1st and 2nd doses for Moderna & Pfizer, contact tracing, case investigations, updating vaccine records, phone calls, scheduling and finance management,

The nurses serving our four county area have done a phenomenal job of serving our communities, including the elderly and homebound. They are now ready to vaccinate anyone 16 and over.

ND National Guard has been supporting LRDHU testing and vaccination clinics since August. Together we will continue to test at least until the end of May.

COVID-19 Walk-in Mass Vaccination clinics have transitioned to appointments only. Call your local Public Health Office to schedule.

We are proud of North Dakota Health & Medical Emergency Preparedness & Response. The assets they provide are available to both state and local public health and medical responders as determined by the NDDOH Incident Command System. The state supply cache was always able to fill our needs of personal protective equipment. They are also responsible for the vaccine and delivery.

More than ever, we have learned to work as a team.
